**ELIGIBILITY:** Incentives are available to Oregon residential electric service customers of Portland General Electric (PGE) and Pacific Power and Oregon residential natural gas service customers of NW Natural, Avista and Cascade Natural Gas. Incentives for clothes washers installed in homes with electric water heat must be within the PGE or Pacific Power service territory. Customers with a gas water heater must subscribe to NW Natural, Avista or Cascade Natural Gas service. Incentives for refrigerators must be installed in homes within the PGE or Pacific Power service territory. Sales receipt must be dated between January 1, 2008 and December 31, 2008. Incentives are available for applications submitted within 90 days from the date of purchase. Limited to one incentive per clothes washer or refrigerator. Regardless of date of purchase, no incentive applications will be accepted after January 31, 2009. Neither Energy Trust nor Portland Energy Conservation, Inc. (PECI) shall be responsible for lost or misdirected mail.

<sup>i</sup> Modified Energy Factor (MEF) measures the energy used during the washing process, including machine energy, water heating energy, and dryer energy. The most efficient clothes washers have the highest MEF ratings.

<sup>ii</sup> The program will maintain this criterion throughout 2008, however, ENERGY STAR criteria changes on April 28, 2008 to include refrigerators 20% more efficient than federal standards. From this point forward, the program will accept all ENERGY STAR qualified refrigerators.
